D'Iberville OKs casino resort plans

D'IBERVILLE — The city council has approved plans for the Royal D'Iberville Casino just west of Interstate 110 on the waterfront.

ADVERTISEMENT Now, developer Mark Seymour needs financing and approval from the Mississippi Gaming Commission.

Seymour's plans include a casino, French Market, restaurants, an 80-slip marina, 400 hotel rooms and a condo hotel.

The D'Iberville council also Tuesday granted a height variance of 60 feet for the 170-foot casino resort, which Seymour said is under the flight path of Keesler Air Force Base.

Seymour has worked for more than a decade to get the casino built.
