The Mississippi Gaming Commission held its regular monthly meeting in the Stuart C. Irby Conference Room of its Jackson office at 9 a.m. on Thursday, February 25, 2010. Commissioners Jerry St. Pe', John Hairston and Nolen Canon were in attendance as well as Executive Director Larry Gregory. The following matters were considered:

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR LICENSURE

Glory (U.S.A.) Inc. appeared before the Mississippi Gaming Commission to obtain approval of the renewal of its license to operate as a manufacturer and distributor. In connection with approval of Glory (U.S.A.) Inc.'s renewal of its license, **GLORY LTD**, also received approval as a registered as a publicly traded corporation as well as certain exemptions related to certain restrictions on the transfer of its securities.

Lakes Game Development, LLC received approval of the renewal of its license to operate as a manufacturer and distributor as well as approval of certain exemptions related to certain restrictions on the transfer of its securities.

WMS Gaming, Inc. received approval of the renewal of its manufacturer and distributor license and approval as a Multi-Site Wide Area Progressive Operator. WMS Gaming also received approval of certain exemptions related to certain restrictions on the transfer of its securities.
