COMMISSION MEETING: November 18, 2010

The Mississippi Gaming Commission held its regular monthly meeting at its office in Jackson, Mississippi, at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, November 18, 2010. Commissioners Jerry St. Pe, John Hairston and Nolen Canon were in attendance as well as Executive Director Larry Gregory. The following matters were considered:

ADMINISTRATIVE UPDATES

The Commissioners approved the minutes from the Commission's meeting held on October 28, 2010.

On October 28, 2010, Greenville Riverboat, LLC merged into Lighthouse Point, LLC with Lighthouse Point, LLC as the surviving entity. Greenville Riverboat, LLC surrendered its license to the Mississippi Gaming Commission on November 3, 2010.

SITE APPROVAL

Rotate Black MS received gaming site approval for its approximately nine and a half (9.5) acre site located at the Bert Jones Yacht Basin in Gulfport, Mississippi.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR LICENSURE

Barden Mississippi Gaming, LLC d/b/a Fitzgeralds Casino Hotel received approval of the renewal of its casino operator's license.

FINDINGS OF SUITABILITY
