The Mississippi Gaming Commission held its regular monthly meeting at its office in Jackson, Mississippi, at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, February 24, 2011. Commissioners Jerry St. Pe, John Hairston and Nolen Canon were in attendance as well as Executive Director Larry Gregory. The following matters were considered:

#### ADMINISTRATIVE UPDATES:

The Commissioners approved the minutes from the Commission's January 27, 2011 meeting.

Jason Seelig, Executive VP for Atlantic City Coin and Slot Service Company, made his personal appearance concerning approvals given at the November, 2010, meeting.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS FOR LICENSURE
