The Mississippi Gaming Commission held its regular monthly meeting at its office in Jackson, Mississippi, on Thursday, July 21, 2011, at 9:00 a.m. Commissioners Jerry St. Pe, John Hairston and Nolan Canon were in attendance. Executive Director Larry Gregory was also in attendance. The following matters were considered:

#### ADMINISTRATIVE UPDATE

Elaine A. Hodgson, President, CEO, Chair of the Board of Directors and Treasurer of Incredible Technologies, Inc. made her personal appearance before the Commission in connection with her finding of suitability approved during the Commission meeting on June, 30, 2011.

#### LICENSING

**Paltronics, Inc.** was approved and granted a manufacturer and distributor license. Paltronics, Inc. manufactures casino gaming system solutions and display technologies. It offers the One Link<sup>®</sup> slot system, a platform that allows casino gaming corporations to centralize the management of slot progressives at one or multiple properties; One Link<sup>®</sup> Media system, which give casinos the ability to centrally create, edit, manage, and "narrowcast" a full range of media content playlists on a multitude of display types at one or more properties; and One Link<sup>®</sup> Table system, a networked platform that provides casino operators with centralized control of linked table games. The company also provides slot and table bonusing, random jackpot, wheel of madness, and bonus spin games, as well as table, in-machine, overhead, and custom light-

emitting diode and liquid crystal displays. In addition, it offers graphics and animation design, and training and implementation services. Paltronics, Inc. was founded in 1992 and is headquartered in Crystal Lake, Illinois.

**Crescent City Ventures, Inc. d/b/a Crescent City School of Gaming and Bartending** was granted approval for its relicensure as a gaming school.

#### FINDINGS OF SUITABILITY

**Gerald W. Koslow**, Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer of *Gaming Partners International USA, Inc.* was found suitable.

#### OTHER APPROVALS

**IGT** received continuous approval for a one (1) year period for involvement in foreign gaming (internet gaming).

#### PATRON DISPUTES

In the case of **Aelicia Allen vs. RIH Acquisitions MS II, LLC d/b/a Bally's Casino Tunica**, the Commission accepted the Decision of the Hearing Examiner.

#### WORK PERMITS

The Mississippi Gaming Commission **accepted** the recommendations of the Hearing Examiner regarding a work permit hearing held and decisions rendered in connection with Danny Wicker and Cardiss Williams.

## WORK PERMITS (CONTINUED)

The Mississippi Gaming Commission denied the work permit application of Twanda Toney and Fitzroy Chambers and approved the permit application of Nakeema Taylor.
